

### Chapter 3

## PROHIBITING SMOKING IN MUNICIPALLY OWNED BUILDINGS

**5-3-1: Definition <sup>1</sup>**

"Smoking" means and includes the carrying of a lighted pipe, lighted cigar or lighted cigarette, regardless of its composition, the possession of any lighted pipe, cigar or cigarette or the lighting of any pipe, cigar or cigarette. (Ord. 2-2003, eff. 9-5-2003)

"Enclosed building" means a roofed structure or portion of a structure having no openings other than windows and doors.

**5-3-2: Prohibition**

Smoking is prohibited in the Westcliffe Town Hall, except in areas that may be designated for smoking by resolution of the Board of Trustees. (Ord. 2-2003, eff. 9-5-2003)

**5-3-3: Posting of Signs**

Signs shall be posted using the words "No Smoking" and/or the international no smoking symbol on all public entrances or in a position clearly visible on entry into the building. Such signs shall have letters no less than two inches high or symbols no less than three inches high. (Ord. 2-2003, eff. 9-5-2003)

**5-3-4: Penalties**

Any person, upon conviction of a violation of any provision of this title, shall be subject to a fine of \$25 for each such violation. (Ord. 2-2003, eff. 9-5-2003)
